* FAIL TO YIELD THE RIGHT OF WAY TO PEDESTRIANS
* WEAVE IN AND OUT OF PEDESTRIANS
* OPERATE WITH SIDES ON THE HANDLEBARS
(BIC CODE 2007 - 15, SECTION 5.01)

ALL E-BIKE AND BICYCLE OPERATORS, WHEN TRAVELING
ON THE ROADWAY MUST:
* WEAR A HELMET (IF UNDER 18 YEARS OLD)
* HAVE PROPER LIGHTING (FIXED WHITE LIGHT IN THE FRONT
AND RED LIGHT IN THE REAR)
* OBEY ALL TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES (STOP SIGNS,
